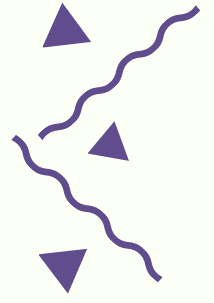
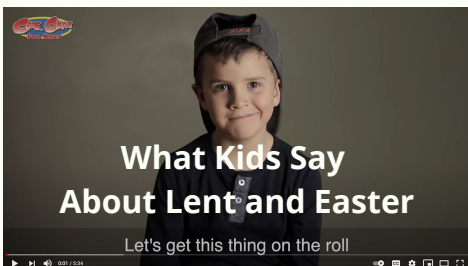

Stations of the Cross

The Way of the Cross is not easy, yet it is the tuneful, the rhythmic, the beautiful, the lovely way.

The Stations of the Cross are a Catholic devotion that commemorates Jesus' last day on Earth. Each of the 14 Stations focus on a specific event of that day. Praying the Stations of the Cross is like a mini pilgrimage. During Lent on Wednesdays and Fridays, and especially on Good Friday, Catholics will embark on this pilgrimage. Why not pray the Stations weekly as a family. A great way to involve your children is to have them colour the 14 Stations. At least once why not take them to see the Stations of the Cross in your home parish.
